A LETTER FROM BRENNA GOURGEOT '18 (LADY PLEIADES THE ELDER)

First, I must thank every single knight on the interim board and elections committee for making the first democratic Casque and Gauntlet Senior Society Board Election possible. The window for online voting is now open and will remain open until July 24, 2021. Mail-in ballots can be printed from the **C&G website**. They must be postmarked by July 20th to be received by the July 24th deadline. You can view all of the bylaws, candidates, their biographies, and their qualifications by clicking **this link**. When you're ready, you can follow **this link** to cast your vote online. We are using a "Ranked Choice Voting" system to appeal to more voters and gather more data. Second, in accordance with the C&G bylaws, we must receive at least 125 votes per election to legitimize the results. Every vote matters! Please do your part and cast your vote.

Ranked Choice Voting

A ranked-choice voting system (RCV) is an electoral system in which voters rank candidates by preference on their ballots. If a candidate wins a majority of first-preference votes, he or she is declared the winner. If no candidate wins a majority of first-preference votes, the candidate with the fewest firstpreference votes is eliminated First-preference votes cast for the failed candidate are eliminated, lifting the second-preference choices indicated on those ballots. A new tally is conducted to determine whether any candidate has won a majority of the adjusted votes. The process is repeated until a candidate wins an outright majority. An example ballot is pictured below.
